

Educational Cued Speech Transliterater

Qualifications:

1. High school diploma
2. Preferred training in Cued Speech and or knowledge of working with learners that are deaf/hard of hearing
3. Demonstrated skill in expressive and receptive cued speech transliterating (Provisional Certificate required as a minimum.)

Job Summary:

1. Provide a student who is deaf with cued speech services at school and subject to other locations in District 196 in any given year. These conversations will be held confidential except in situations addressed in Professional Educational Ethics code.
2. Provide cued speech services for interactions between student and peers. These conversations will be held confidential except in situations addressed in Professional Educational Ethics code.
3. Provide cued speech services at school activities, field trips and extra-curricular activities as needed within the school day.
4. Becomes knowledgeable and proficient with classroom vocabulary.
5. Responsible for physical setup within mainstream classrooms facilitating effective receptiveness for use of manual communication.
6. Communicate any problems observed the student may have in regular classrooms with teachers of Deaf/Hard of Hearing.
7. Assist with in-servicing regular education teachers and administrators regarding classroom cued speech services.
8. Travel between buildings (mileage reimbursed).
