- **Professional Development**: Initiate and maintain active participation in professional development opportunities that encompass the discipline and teaching effectiveness.
- **Philosophy**: Continually strive to achieve the college **Mission**, **Vision** and **Purposes**, and model the college's **Valued Practices**.
