### **Minimum Qualifications**

- 1. Must possess or eligible to obtain National Council for Therapeutic Recreation Certification (NCTRC)
- 2. Must possess Bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited college or university with a concentration in therapeutic recreation or a major in recreation or leisure with an option in therapeutic recreation
- 3. Must possess or eligible to obtain a New Mexico Public Education Instructional Support Provider License

## **Performance Responsibilities**

- 1. Conduct appropriate standardized assessments of student performance, record, and disseminate results and plan to aid in the development of students' IEP
- 2. To build play/exploration skills necessary for mature, socially acceptable interactions for learning and to formulate appropriate adaptive responses to school and community environments



- 3. Provide students with an increased understanding of leisure and the opportunity to acquire new leisure skills and attitudes through leisure education programs
- 4. Utilize activity task analysis
- 5. Implement interventions in least restrictive environment
- 6. Provide specially designed instruction to develop students' functional skills utilizing adaptive equipment, supportive techniques, and appropriate accommodations to accomplish the acquisition, maintenance, and generalization of skills in multiple settings
- 7. Monitor environment for safety concerns and modify interventions as necessary
- 8. Explain the purpose and outcomes of selected interventions to student and/or appropriate others
- 9. Provide in-service education and serve as consultant to teachers and school staff members as appropriate
- 10. To facilitate exposure to new naturalistic environments including community access outings and inclusion with peers which aides in the transition from school to home and community
- 11. Evaluate individual and program outcomes and modify interventions and teaching strategies as necessary
- 12. Maintain confidential records and documentation appropriate to the development of the IEP and student progress
- 13. Maintain equipment, materials and supply inventory
- 14. Pursue professional growth through participation in in-services and staff development activities as appropriate
- 15. Provide information, support and strategies to parents and families to promote inclusion and participation in leisure and recreation
- 16. Maintain knowledge of current professional Standards of Practice, Scope of Practice and Code of Ethics
- 17. Promote district, RT services and the profession through marketing and public relations
- 18. Comply with local, state and federal regulations
- 19. Perform other related tasks as assigned
- 20. Exhibit professionalism by maintaining good attendance and adhering to contract hours
- 21. Other duties as assigned within the scope of the assigned positions
- 22. Agree to fulfill performance responsibilities in locations assigned
