SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Develop Individual Educational Programs for students with varying functioning levels.
2. Develop long and short term learning goals and objectives according to program guidelines and the IEP.
3. Conduct daily classroom activities reflecting IEP goals and objectives.
4. Utilize a variety of techniques and materials to execute appropriate curriculum.
5. Maintain appropriate student behavior control.
6. Maintain a productive classroom environment.
7. Establish an instructional pace consistent with students' learning process.
8. Monitor student performance and progress, adjusting instruction as necessary.
9. Compile and maintain necessary records and progress notes.
10. Participate as part of multi-disciplinary team.
11. Maintain orderliness and safety of instructional areas.
12. Conduct parent conferences as necessary.
13. Plan and supervise the functions of teacher aides/assistants.
14. Facilitate extra-curricular physical education programs.
15. Develop physical education curriculum appropriate to exceptional needs of students.
