- 4. Diagnose operating problems, repairs and replaces parts to all HVAC equipment as needed.
- 5. Assists in maintaining all boiler systems.
- 6. Assists in maintaining an adequate inventory of supplies, materials, and tools.
- 7. Assists in following outlined procedures for the requisition of replacement parts, etc.
- 8. Operates trucks to and from work destinations and accepts responsibility for the proper operation and care of vehicles equipment assigned to the HVAC service.
- 9. Performs such other duties as the Director may require.
