- Provides direct counseling services to students with IEPs and 504s, including students with multi-needs and autism
- Provide interventions to nonidentified students to support the teaching process and to maximize learning and adjustment
- Teaches students how to develop effective learning strategies and personal and social skills.
- Counsels students on educational and personal adjustment issues.
- Provides consultation to parents, teachers, other school personnel, and community agencies to enhance the learning and adjustment of students.
- Assists in the planning, development, and evaluation of programs to meet identified learning and adjustment needs.
- Delivers a planned and coordinated program of counseling services.
- Communicates effectively with students, parents, and school staff.
- Plans and implements in-service programs for staff and/or parents.
- Plans, maintains, and/or participates in a system of accountability for services delivered.
- Effectively communicates knowledge and ideas orally and in writing to individuals and groups
- Maintains effective interpersonal relationships and communication in the professional setting.
- Work with team to complete functional behavior assessment and write behavior intervention plans.
- Work collaboratively with district psychologists and building social workers
- Assist grade level teams in reviewing data and establishing academic and behavioral interventions
