Responsibilities:

- Assess, evaluate, analyze, diagnose, and write psychological reports.
- Review student records, organize information and determine appropriate assessment battery.
- Assess students' cognitive ability, social-emotional development, adaptive behavior, language development, academic achievement, and both academic and social/emotional needs.
- Participate in the decision-making process regarding special placement of students.
- Provide diagnostic services, counseling, and recommendations for students with special needs.
- Participate in Individual Education Plan meetings with students and parents as needed.
- Conduct psychological assessments and diagnostic evaluations to identify students' needs.
- Develop and implement IEPs in collaboration with teachers and parents.
- Provide crisis intervention services to students experiencing emotional or behavioral challenges.
- Work with students with disabilities to provide tailored support and accommodations.
- Collaborate with school staff to promote mental health awareness and implement school-wide programs.
- Maintain accurate medical documentation related to student care and interventions.
- Communicate effectively with students, parents, and school staff.
- Assist grade level teams in reviewing data and establishing academic and behavioral interventions
