Qualifications:

Must hold Illinois State Board of Education Professional Educator License (PEL).

• Learning Behavior Specialist 1 with BCBA or LBS II Preferred.

Performance Responsibilities:

- Instructs assigned classes in the locations and at the times designated.
- Plans and implements a curriculum that meets the student's needs, interests, and abilities.
- Creates a classroom environment that is conducive to learning and appropriate to the maturity and interests of the students.
- Prepares for classes assigned and shows written evidence of preparation upon request of the supervisor.
- Establishes and maintains standards of behavior.
- Guides the learning process toward achieving the district curriculum, establishes clear objectives for all lessons, and communicates these objectives to students.
- Employs a variety of research-based instructional techniques and instructional media that address students' individual needs.
- Assesses the accomplishments of students regularly and provides progress reports as required.
- Takes all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect students, equipment, materials, and facilities.
- Maintains accurate, complete, and correct records as required by law, district policy, and administrative regulation.
- Relates and communicates effectively to students, staff, and parents.
- Performs other tasks and assumes other responsibilities as the supervisor may assign.

Evaluation: The principal or assistant principal will evaluate this position in accordance with the Collective Bargaining Agreement.
