Coordinates with Migrant Program Specialist and appropriate migrant staff to determine the learning needs of assigned students, coordinates their individualized instructional program and organizes subject matter and instructional delivery to meet the differentiated needs of students. Participates in the on-going in-service program of the Migrant Education Program District and county as appropriate to Migrant education student needs. Assists school personnel in the selection and assignment of student participants in the program, and consults with appropriate personnel in Migrant verification, enrollment and withdrawal procedures. Functions as a team member on the staff. Performs clerical and record maintenance duties dictated by the position as required. Maintains a comfortable, attractive environment conducive to student learning in areas of assignment. Ensures and exhibits proper control and discipline of assigned students. Provides individual student/or small group instruction to Migrant students as appropriate. Participates in in-service trainings for non-migrant teachers and paraeducators as needed. Utilizes District assessment instruments and programs in order to inform supplemental needs of Migrant students, and adjust student instruction and support. Attends and participates in meetings, and parent involvement activities as required. Uses technology for teaching, student learning and assessment. Performs related work as appropriate to enhance the supplementary nature of the Migrant Education Program.
