The Speech Language Pathologist provides diagnostic, remedial and consultative services for high school students with communicative disorders.

3. Supervise the maintenance of records of student's progress, assist with the preparation of Speech/Language materials, file reports, IEP's and caseload documents.

5. Other duties as assigned as related to speech and language services.
