**Experience Credit:** Up to ten (10) years of prior certified contracted experience may be granted and are compensated based upon education level.

**Education Credit:** Compensation may be granted for job related eligible coursework completed within the last 10 years beyond your highest degree attained. A maximum of 45 credits beyond a BA and 75 credits beyond an MA will be compensated at \$60 per credit hour. All professional growth credits must be presented and considered at the time of initial placement; credits completed prior to hire date will not be considered after initial placement.

**Performance Pay:** Performance Pay (funded through Prop 301) is awarded to all eligible staff that successfully meet the eligibility requirements and meet the measures set forth in the District Performance Pay Framework.

**Sign On Compensation:** Up to \$750 for signing your contract within the first five (5) days of being issued. This compensation is prorated based on when the employee is hired and when the contract is signed.
