



**CLASSIFIED HOURLY (Non-Exempt)  
Hiring Guidelines and Placement Schedule  
SY 2026-27**

**Experience Credit:** Up to ten (10) years of prior related experience may be granted. All prior related experience must be presented and considered at the time of initial placement. Prior experience will not be considered after initial placement.

**Education Credit:** Compensation may be granted for job related eligible coursework completed within the last ten (10) years beyond your highest degree attained. All professional growth credits must be presented and considered at the time of initial placement. Professional growth credits completed prior to hire date will not be considered after initial placement.

**Performance Pay:** Performance Pay is awarded to all eligible staff that successfully meet the eligibility requirements and meet the measures set forth in the District Performance Pay Framework.

**Sign On Compensation:** Up to \$500 for signing your contract within the first five (5) days of being issued. This compensation is prorated based on when the employee is hired and when the contract is signed.
