Job Summary

- Responsible for supporting student achievement in the area of Mathematics with special attention to Tier 1 and Tier II instruction. The Interventionist provides individual or small group instruction to students who are in need of personalized support in order to meet grade level mathematics standards. This includes monitoring, reporting, and communicating student progress and performance.
- Responsible for supporting mathematics teachers in designing, delivering, and evaluating effectiveness of Tier 1 and TierII math interventions in the block schedule.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

60% Student Intervention Instruction

- Provide high quality mathematics instruction to individual students and small groups
- Use data to provide instruction to students and to bring their skills to grade-level
- Use identified research-based interventions focuses specifically on individual student needs
- Maintain documentation of progress monitoring of student performance
- Communicate with teachers, administration, and families regarding student progress
- Participate in meetings with teachers, administration, and families to discuss student placement and progress

40% Math Teacher Support and Coaching

- Collaborate with teachers, administration, and SISA to help identify best practices for individual and small groups of students
- Provide input for program development
- Model lessons and strategies for the block schedule
- Support maths curriculum implementation fidelity for grades 6-8
- Provide data to school teams and participates in decisions about student progress
- Assist with identifying students for placement in intervention groups
- Support implementation of assessment tools and data management systems
- Attend appropriate trainings to improve knowledge and skills
- Collaborate with SISA to provide professional development for math instruction.
