DESCRIPTION: The seasonal Fleet maintenance worker, under the supervision of the Fleet Department Superintendent and Crew Leader, will perform skilled work in the maintenance and repair of city vehicles and maintenance facility. The employee in this position shall clean and organize the vehicle, the maintenance repair bays, seal floors, change tires, help mechanics as needed, parts running, shovel and blow snow around the maintenance facility and performs similar laborious tasks. This is a temporary position. Hours are Monday-Friday 7:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

Ability to perform any of the following tasks:

- Operate small and medium trucks with a trailer.
- Operate some small motorized equipment, including floor sweepers, snow blowers, floor scrubbers, and tire changer.
- Work with fulltime Mechanics as an assistant performing vehicle and building maintenance.
- Ability to perform heavy physical work, lift and carry heavy awkward objects.
- Ability to stock parts and organize parts room.
- Ability to clean vehicles and equipment with pressure washer.
- Use small hand tools and power tools such as shovel, broom, or circular saw.
- Ability to empty trash cans.
- Other duties as assigned.
- Variety of hand tools including shovels, broom, squeegee and rakes.
- Variety of power tools including: air impacts, drills, grinders.
