CLEANER

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: This is routine and repetitive physical work involving the efficient and economical performance of building cleaning and related tasks. Cleaning tasks are performed according to a well established procedure. The work is performed under the supervision of an immediate supervisor. The incumbent does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (illustrative only)

Sweeps, vacuums, mops and washes floors and stairs;

Uses heavy mechanical equipment in stripping, waxing and polishing floors;

Dusts chairs, tables, desks and other furniture;

Polishes furniture and brass;

Empties wastebaskets, collects and disposes of trash;

Arranges chairs and tables and other equipment for special use of building;

Moves furniture, supplies and other equipment;

Cleans windows, walls, bath fixtures, equipment, beds and furniture;

May load and unload trucks;

May operate clothes washer and dryer in laundering of linens clothing, etc.;

Performs custodial tasks as needed.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Working knowledge of common cleaning, disinfecting methods, materials and equipment; skill in the use of cleaners and maintenance equipment (e.g., vacuum cleaner, carpet shampooer and floor buffer); ability to understand and follow simple oral and written directions; ability to lift heavy objects and perform work requiring bending, climbing, reaching, and repetitive motion; ability to get along well with others; willingness to perform routine cleaning and other physical tasks; willingness to be exposed to dust, dirt, grease and grime; dependability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
