- Certified teacher (03, 09) with an endorsement to teach Spanish as a foreign language or foreign equivalent (not a bilingual endorsement)
- Directly related experience
- Native or native-like Spanish skills
- Experience teaching adults preferred

Duties & Responsibilities

- Prepare lessons and teach classes to district staff members
- Attend in-service training to develop a curriculum to meet the specific needs of staff members
- Take attendance

Working Environment:

The job is performed in a minimal temperature environment and is generally a hazard-free setting.

Physical requirements

Regularly required to sit, stand, walk, talk, hear, operate a computer, or other office equipment, reach with hands and arms, and must occasionally lift and/or move up to 30 pounds.

Dates: 1 day/week, October- March (21-24 weeks)

Hours: After school - 1 to 1.5 hours per class for each level (Beginner & intermediate)
