Major Responsibilities/Key Duties

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- 1. Support Coaching Philosophy**
 - Assist the head coach in implementing a cohesive coaching philosophy, skills, and techniques to develop athletes at all levels.
 - Contribute to the creation of a positive, inclusive, and competitive environment for student-athletes.
- 2. Practice and Game Assistance**
 - Help organize and lead practices, ensuring all drills and activities align with the program's goals.
 - Support the head coach during meets and events, assisting with team logistics, strategy, and athlete performance feedback.
- 3. Student Supervision**
 - Ensure the safety and proper supervision of athletes during practices, games, and travel.
 - Enforce team rules and foster respect, sportsmanship, and accountability among athletes.
- 4. Administrative Support**
 - Assist with maintaining compliance with NFHS, IHSA, IESA, and SAC rules and regulations.
 - Help manage athlete eligibility, physical forms, and other required documentation.
 - Submit necessary reports, such as injury forms or rosters, in a timely and organized manner.
- 5. Equipment and Facilities**

- Support the head coach in managing equipment, including issuing, collecting, and maintaining inventory.
