

ParaPro Assessment Now Offered at FSCJ

Florida State College at Jacksonville's Downtown Campus Assessment and Certification Center now offers the ParaPro Assessment to certify teachers' aides and assistants to instruct school children.

The ParaPro Assessment is for both prospective and practicing paraprofessionals. It measures skills and knowledge in reading, math and writing, and the ability to apply those skills and knowledge to assist in classroom instruction. This computer-based test is 2½ hours and consists of 90 multiple-choice questions. The exam fee is \$50 and is nonrefundable. Please be prepared to pay the \$50 exam fee with a debit/credit card upon arriving at the assessment center. ETS policy requires that a test taker wait 21 days to repeat the test if needed.
