- 5. Make necessary accommodations to tests, worksheets, and charts.
- 6. Collaborate with SPED teacher and general education teacher for lesson plan accommodations.
- 7. Participate in staff training programs, facility meetings as assigned.
- 8. Provide any IEP progress collected to SPED teacher.
- 9. Be available by phone, email, or video conferencing to confer with district personnel, students, and/or parents.
- 10. Communicate with students or parents on a regular basis via phone or video conference, email, or district-approved website.
- 11. Maintain confidentiality.
- 12. Follow district safety protocols and emergency procedures.
