## **FUNCTION OF IOB**

Under the general supervision of the superintendent, the direct supervision of the director of Special Services and building principal, and the immediate supervision of the transportation supervisor, the bus attendant will provide services in accordance with the State of Ohio's <u>Rules for the Education of the Handicapped Children</u> and the <u>Ohio Model Policies and Procedures for Educating Children with Disabilities</u>. These services shall include assisting the appointed disabled student with personal health care needs within the confines of the transportation setting.

## **CHARACTERISTIC DUTIES**

- 1. Will accompany and attend to the needs of the student to and from the transportation source for the student and will insure that the student safely gets out of the transportation source to the classroom and vice versa.
- 2. Will attend to the personal health care needs and safety needs of the appointed student in the transportation setting.
- 3. Perform other tasks as directed by the transportation supervisor, building principal, special services director, or superintendent.

## **OUALIFICATIONS**

- 1. High school graduate or equivalent.
- 2. Must relate to students and adults in a positive manner.
- 3. Must be physically able to perform duties.
  - a. Must be able to lift 60 lbs. unassisted.
