PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Build positive, professional relationships with students and staff
- 2. Respond to requests promptly and respectfully
- 3. Be dependable with attendance to work in addition to properly using a punch clock system correctly in correlation to arriving to work and leaving work
- 4. Follow established safety protocols and practices
- 5. Daily supervision includes but is not limited to building entrances/exits, hallways, restrooms, classrooms, locker rooms, study hall, detention, cafeteria, student center, bus lanes and any other areas where students may congregate
- 6. Encourage appropriate behavior in common areas and restrooms throughout the building
- 7. Assist with prompting students to their assigned location
- 8. Ability to be on feet and walk throughout the assigned work day to actively supervise students
- 9. Engage in respectful conversations with students, redirect students as needed and be proactive in de-escalating situations that may arise
