The total pre-K through 12 student population in 2024-2025 was approximately 7,400 students.

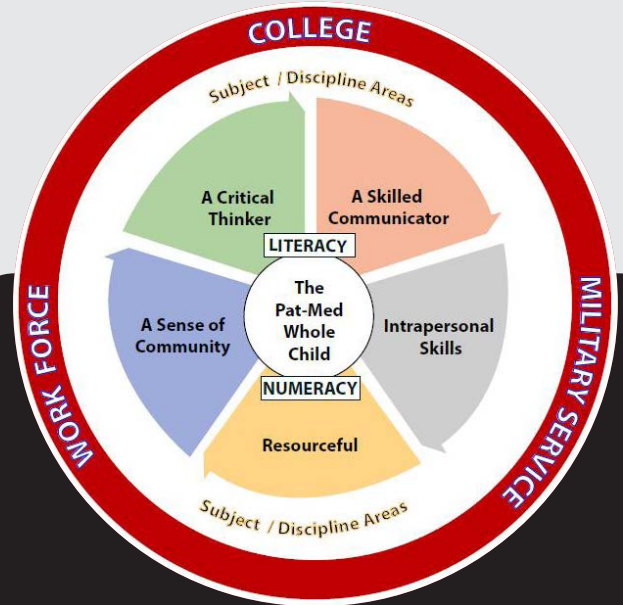
