

## **Transportation - Bus Driver**

## Responsibilities:

- Be physically and mentally alert
- Obey all traffic laws
- Observe all mandatory bus safety regulations
- Transport only authorized students.
- Maintain discipline when students are on the bus and report undisciplined students to the proper authority
- Adhere to the designated route description and stops assigned
- Keep assigned bus swept and cleaned
- Preform pre-trip bus inspection before each departure from the transportation facility
- Fuel the bus daily and record the fuel used
- Notify the proper authority in case of mechanical failure
- Discharge students only at authorized stops
- Enforce all rules and regulations listed on student conduct policy posted
- Perform other duties and responsibilities assigned by the Director of Transportation

## Mental Demands/Physical Demands/Environmental Factors:

- Tools/Equipment Used: Operate school bus; two-way radio; global positioning system (GPS);
  safety equipment including but not limited to flares, reflective signs, and fire extinguisher
- Posture: Prolonged driving; moderate walking; frequent climbing stairs, grasping/squeezing, wrist and shoulder flexion/extension, and reaching
- Lifting: Limited light lifting and carrying (less than 15 pounds) on a daily basis
- **Environment:** Frequent exposure to extreme hot and cold temperatures, noise, and vehicle fumes; work around moving vehicles; regularly work irregular hours, and occasionally work prolonged hours
- Mental Demands: Maintain emotional control under stress

## **Qualifications:**

- Texas Commercial Driver's License
- Bus Driver's Physical Examination
- Must be 21 years of age or older

<u>Other Information:</u> Fingerprinting: All potential candidates must adhere to and meet the requirements set forth in **Texas Education Code (TEC), Chapter 22, Subchapter C prior to employment**.
