TITLE: PRE-NURSING INSTRUCTOR

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Bachelor's degree in Career Field and at least 2 years of full-time related nursing work experience, 6,000 hours of which occurred within the last five years, or
- 2. Successful applicants must have at least five recent years of experience in the healthcare field, including a minimum of 3,200 hours in a long-term care facility (as defined by the Ohio Department of Health) and be able to secure a license as a career/technical instructor
