	Work with PAWS Program Coordinator to make daily contact with current program participant's classroom teachers regarding work and support while in the program and transitioning back to the classroom after program completion.
	Work with PAWS Program Coordinator to coordinate mindfulness and/or movement activity options at end of each day
	Provide overall active supervision and discipline within PAWS and ISS programs and address behavioral concerns that may arise with participants using established program protocol and the school-wide behavior response plan.
