- Provide experiential and integrated learning in reading, math, art and science.
- Provide a variety of alternative learning techniques and experiences for the students.

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- Promote, implement, evaluate and maintain quality youth programs offered through Eden Prairie Community Education.
- Work directly with students leading activities, providing supervision, maintaining a safe, child-friendly environment.
- Help promote program using materials designed by Community Education.
- Focus on parent communication.
- Provide direction to students during activities and throughout transitions.
- Provide supervision in indoor and outdoor spaces at a ratio of 15:1.
- Stay informed of daily programs and activities.
- Take work direction from Targeted Services Coordinator as needed.
