- V. <u>JOB GOAL</u>: To provide leadership at the PK-12 level for the effective implementation of Social Studies curriculum and cross-curricular Evidence-Based Learning.

VI: MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Oversee the district focus necessary for a dynamic PK-12 Social Studies curriculum focused on a high level of student engagement through authentic and academic learning experiences.
- 2. Create, implement, supervise, and evaluate a knowledge-based and content-rich curriculum.
- 3. Oversee the district focus necessary for Student-Centered Learning PK-12.
- 4. Work closely with the Executive Director of PK-12 Literacy, the Chief Academic Officer, and the entire senior leadership team to ensure vertical articulation and consistent implementation of Social Studies PK-12.
- 5. Supervise and evaluate teachers as determined by the Chief Academic Officer and building-level leadership.
- 6. Support the implementation of district programs and curriculum. Provide guidance to school leaders and teachers on evidence-based practices.
- 7. Lead and assist school leaders in analyzing data to improve student achievement. Analyze student performance data to inform practice and present findings.
- 8. Lead and organize visits to elementary and secondary programs with respective staff.
- 9. Provide leadership necessary for the Social Studies Department to function effectively.
- 10. Assist teachers in integrating Student-Centered Learning tailored for Grades PK through 12 that demonstrates and supports instructional practices utilizing technology integration and cross-curricular collaboration.
- 11. Oversee the district's focus on integrating an evidence-based learning methodology to provide learning opportunities for students.

- 12. Assist teachers in the development of assessments, including common, formative, summative, and project-based assessments that align with Fairfield's curriculum.
- 13. Plan, implement, and oversee all curriculum development and revision projects, including presentations to the BOE and other stakeholder groups.
- 14. Foster communication within the Executive Leadership Team by maintaining a collaborative and thoughtful approach to operating as a team.
- 15. Foster communication in Social Studies PK-12 to engage and inspire innovation, collaboration, and creativity.
- 16. Under the Chief Academic Officer, oversee processes such as textbook adoption, professional development implementation, and instructional coaching and improvement.
- 17. Collaborate and communicate effectively with building administrators in matters specific to department or school issues or needs.
- 18. Participate on the team as part of the teacher induction process to Fairfield Public Schools and serve as an ongoing resource to teachers in PK-12. Be the direct support for new teachers in the social studies department, including providing mentorship and partnerships through the induction and TEAM programs.
- 19. Provide input to the Executive Leadership Team during budget preparation with equipment, staffing, and materials, including price and/or bid information on texts, supplies, and equipment repairs.

 Maintain the department's budget throughout the fiscal year with appropriate resource allocations.
- 20. Plan and develop group and individual professional learning plans, presentations, and programs for teachers and administrators.
- 21. Supervise the Social Studies curriculum, instruction, and assessment articulation from prekindergarten through twelfth grade for alignment to state and federal standards, district and board goals, and interdisciplinary connection.
- 22. Plan and implement instructional improvement through cross-curricular integration of the curriculum's content knowledge and skills throughout the PK-12 system.
- 23. Improve student performance, including (but not exhaustive) Smarter Balanced, PSAT, and SAT, as a direct result of the implementation of the social studies curriculum and the position's leadership.
- 24. Maintain and keep the district's electronic curriculum platforms up to date.
- 25. Maintain membership and provide leadership at the district's professional development and evaluation council.
- 26. Address parent and community concerns regarding the social studies academic program and its resulting student performance.

- 27. Collaborate with building-level leadership while maintaining and supporting the district's focus, vision, and goals.
- 28. Any other duties as assigned by the Chief Academic Officer or Executive Director of PK-12 Literacy.
- 29. Assist in any other district functions as requested by the Superintendent or designee.
