- QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidates must hold, or be eligible to hold, a certificate issued by the Wyoming Professional Teaching Standards Board with an endorsement as a principal. Experience as an elementary teacher and as an administrator is desired. The ideal candidate is a strong instructional leader with the ability to collaborate with district administration and teachers to solve problems and implement solutions; has knowledge of the elementary-level learner (especially literacy and math skills); establishes and maintains positive relationships with students, staff, and parents; maintains high visibility throughout the school; understands positive behavior intervention and support; has the ability to work with at-risk students and students with behavioral challenges; is willing to listen, be innovative, and generate new ideas; has strong data analysis skills to make systemic and programmatic changes; is committed to supporting strong Professional Learning Community (PLC) teams to ensure all students learn at high levels; has strong communication and interpersonal relationship skills; and has experience with standards-based grading and implementation.
- DESCRIPTION:** This position will serve as Principal of a K-3 elementary school with approximately 450 students. The Principal's responsibilities include the supervision and evaluation of certified and classified staff; development, planning and implementation of building level initiatives; planning and delivery of professional development; supervision, discipline, and monitoring of students. The Principal implements and enforces school district policies, state rules, and regulations. The Principal also works cooperatively with the Superintendent and administrative team to support the district's mission, vision, and values.
