**POSITION:** Adaptive PE Teacher(summer temporary at-will position)  
**LOCATION:** Varies depending upon grade level  
**SALARY:** \$60.00 per hour (instructional) / \$50.00 per hour (non-instructional)

**DATES:** Elementary, Middle School, the majority of students' needs can be met Monday through Thursday.

Certified prep time is 30 minutes each day; instructional time is between 8:00 a.m. and 11:30 am (individual student schedules will be determined through consultation between parents and teachers).

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidates must hold, or be eligible to hold, Wyoming certification as an Adaptive PE teacher and appropriate licensure. The ability and willingness to provide services to students of varying grade levels is required. Previous experience as a school-based APE Teacher is preferred, and familiarity with Fremont #1 policies and procedures is also preferred. Other qualifications include: ability to coordinate schedules with special education teachers, paraprofessionals, and general summer school teachers to meet student needs. Successful candidates must be able to commit to Session One and/or Session Two.

**DESCRIPTION:** Summer Adaptive PE Teacher (APE) provide APE to students who require these services during summer months when school is not typically in session. Services are delivered according to each student's Individualized Education Program (IEP) goals.
