Summary:

Fort Lupton High School is seeking a dedicated and enthusiastic Junior Varsity / Assistant Volleyball Coach for the upcoming school year. The ideal candidate has prior coaching experience, is passionate about teaching the game of volleyball, and is committed to helping student-athletes grow both on and off the court.

This position serves as the primary coach for the Junior Varsity program while working under the direction of the High School Head Coach to support the overall vision, expectations, and success of the volleyball program. The JV/Assistant Coach will collaborate with athletes, families, staff, feeder programs, and the community to develop a positive, competitive, and student-centered culture.

Responsibilities:

Program Leadership

- Serve as the head coach of the Junior Varsity team, including planning and leading JV practices, matches, and team activities.
- Assist the Head Coach with overall program operations, scheduling, communication, and implementation of program goals.
- Support alignment of program philosophy, systems, and expectations between Varsity, JV, C-Team, and middle school levels.
- Assist in supervising lower-level coaches and volunteers as assigned.
- Coordinate with the athletic department regarding schedules, transportation, equipment, uniforms, and facility use.
- Ensure compliance with all school, district, league, and CHSAA policies and procedures.
- Help promote a positive team culture built on accountability, integrity, pride, and perseverance.

Athlete Development

- Teach volleyball fundamentals, skill development, and team concepts appropriate for the JV level.
- Prepare student-athletes for advancement within the high school program.
- Encourage academic achievement, responsibility, sportsmanship, and strong character.
- Provide regular feedback, mentorship, and encouragement to support individual growth.
- Assist with off-season development opportunities and program retention efforts.



Communication & Relationship

- Maintain clear, professional, and timely communication with players, parents, coaching staff, and administration.
- Support strong relationships with feeder middle school programs, youth programs, and the community.
- Represent the school and volleyball program in a positive and professional manner at all times.

Safety & Supervision

- Maintain a safe, respectful, and inclusive environment for all participants.
- Supervise student-athletes during practices, competitions, travel, and team events.
- Respond appropriately to injuries, emergencies, and student concerns following district protocols.

Qualifications:

- Previous coaching and/or competitive playing experience in volleyball preferred.
- Knowledge of volleyball fundamentals, rules, and player development strategies.
- Strong leadership, organization, and communication skills.
- Ability to build positive relationships with students, families, and staff.
- CPR/First Aid certified (or willingness to obtain upon hire).
- Must pass a background check, sign the coaches manual, and meet all district/coaching requirements
