- If the head coach is found holding practices without being certified or a certified coach present, then this will be grounds for dismissal.
- 2) Hold a valid Alaska or US Driver's License
 - The Head Coach must be able to drive and transport if traveling with the team.
- 3) Verified completed background check through GCSD Human Resources.

Job Description

- Hold a pre-season meeting prior to the first practice to review participation requirements and schedule. This can be done both in person and virtual if needed.

7th-12th Student Participation:

- Ensure that all 7-12 participants have all required forms completed prior to practicing.
- Conduct an early-season student-athlete survey centered around why they joined and their goal(s) for the season.

Practices:

- Develop a written practice plan for each practice.
- Conduct at minimum four 1-1.5 hour physical practices for each full week.
 - Practices are to be conducted at the GILA Gymnasium from 4:30-6:00 PM.
 - Coaches are expected to be present 10-15 minutes before and 10-15 minutes after each practice. Coaches cannot leave practice until all students have been picked up or checked out accordingly.
 - No Sunday practices are permitted.
- Keep an up-to-date practice log provided by the Activities Director for all participants.

Meets & Travel

- Coach and chaperone all scheduled meets.
- Coordinate and judge a state tryout meet for Galena participants
 - Only family emergencies and being sick will be grounds for being excused from these duties.

 - Note: children are not permitted to travel with the team.
- Being a driver for transporting students
