Summary or Purpose:

The Driver position is responsible for the transportation of students, staff, and equipment to and from scheduled events.

- On-call, per request of the Activities Director.
- Primary days: Saturday & Sunday (with additional weekday assignments as needed).
- Ability to work flexible hours, including weekends and evenings.

Qualification Requirements:

- Verified completed background check through GCSD Human Resources.
 - **other background checks do not suffice this requirement.
- Must hold a valid Alaska Driver's License with a clean driving record.
- Minimum age of 21 years.
- Experience driving short buses or vans preferred.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills

Performance Responsibilities:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skills, and/or abilities required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- 1. Safely operate a district short bus or van to transport students, staff, and equipment to and from scheduled events.
- 2. Follow all Alaska traffic laws and district transportation policies.
- 3. Reporting any maintenance or safety concerns immediately.
- 4. Maintain discipline and safety during transport in accordance with district expectations.
- 5. Communicate promptly with the Activities Director regarding schedule changes, travel delays, or incidents.
- 6. Assist students and staff with loading/unloading equipment or supplies when needed.

Physical Requirements

While performing the duties of this job the employee is regularly required to drive; sit; stand; walk; use hands to finger, handle or feels objects, tools, controls; and reach with hands and arms.
