Primary Purpose:

Perform preventative maintenance repairs to the interior and exterior of school buildings and other district facilities. This position requires working four ten-hour days on the evening shift.

Qualifications:

Education/Certification:

High School Diploma or equivalent

Valid Texas driver's license with good driving record

Experience:

Minimum of two (2) years of experience in general maintenance preferred

Special Knowledge/Skills:

- Knowledge of general maintenance
- Knowledge of crafts, such as: carpentry, flooring, ceramic tile, glass glazing, painting, drywall, minor plumbing, ceiling tiles, cabinet making, construction, and minor electrical repairs (ballasts & lamps)
- Ability to use a computer
- Ability to work well with others
- Ability to follow instructions

Major Responsibilities and Duties:

- 1. Complete assignments in a timely and acceptable manner.
- 2. Maintain inventory of supplies and equipment.
- 3. Perform carpentry repairs to school buildings and other district facilities.
- 4. Perform repairs to floor coverings, ceramic tile, and cove base.
- 5. Perform minor plumbing, HVAC, electrical, glass, and ceiling tile/grid repairs.
- 6. Perform wall repairs, painting, texture, tape & bed and drywall installation.
- 7. Perform wall stud installations and have the ability to make cabinets if needed.
- 8. Operate/drive a service vehicle, following all state rules and regulations.
- 9. Use a computer to log work hours and close work orders.
- 10. Work safely with power tools, hand tools, lifts, and equipment.
- 11. Perform all other duties as assigned.

Mental Demands/Physical Demands/Environmental Factors

Tools/Equipment Used: Standard office equipment, including personal computer and peripherals; may use small hand tools and power tools; light truck or van

Posture: Frequent standing, kneeling/squatting, bending/stooping, pushing/pulling, and twisting; may work in tiring and uncomfortable positions.



Motion: Frequent walking; climbing stairs; ladders/scaffolding; regular grasping/squeezing, wrist flexion/extension, and overhead reaching; frequent driving

Lifting: Regular moderate lifting and carrying (15-44 pounds); occasional heavy lifting (45 pounds and over)

Environment: Work outside and inside on slippery or uneven walking surfaces; frequent exposure to extreme hot and cold temperatures, dust, noise, vibration; exposure to chemical and electrical hazards; work around machinery with moving parts; regularly work irregular hours; occasional prolonged hours; frequent districtwide travel
