The Community

The District

Kearsley Community Schools serves approximately 2,900 students in Northeast Genesee County. The district has three elementary schools, one middle school, and one high school. Additional programming includes dedicated Social Workers in <u>ALL</u> school buildings, the character strength building "P2 - Positivity Project®" at grade levels DK - 8, expanded dual enrollment opportunities, cutting-edge technology in all classrooms, and a nationally recognized Bike Tech® program at Kearsley High School that prepares students for jobs of the future. The Position

Under the direction of the <u>Building Principal</u> or designee, the **Student Success Coordinator** will having the following job requirements:
