QUALIFICATIONS

BASIC DUTIES

- Mop, sweep, and scrub floors and other surfaces.
- Clean and renew floor surfaces.
- Clean and dust furniture, show cases, fixtures, windows, doors, and related furnishings.
- Wash and clean light fixtures.
- Clean and disinfect all drinking fountains and lavatories assigned.
- Work on ladders and scaffolds when required.
- Perform other duties related to job classification.
- Perform other duties as may be assigned by the Supervisors or the Building Principal.
