- Develop, implement, and maintain compliant Individualized Education Programs (IEPs).
- Collaborate with classroom teachers, parents, related service personnel, and support staff to meet student needs.
- Support students through accommodations, modifications, and evidence-based instructional practices.
- Assess student needs using formal and informal measures and utilize data to inform instruction.
- Assist students in developing academic, social-emotional, interpersonal, and independent living skills.
- Train, supervise, and collaborate with paraeducators to support student learning.
- Maintain accurate student records and ensure compliance with district, state, and federal regulations.
- Follow all district policies, procedures, and safety protocols.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Building Administrator.
