QUALIFICATIONS

- Master's Degree in Social Work from an accredited institution.
- Valid Michigan School Social Worker Approval issued by the Michigan Department of Education.
- Valid Michigan Limited Licensed Master Social Worker (LLMSW) or Licensed Master Social Worker (LMSW) credential.
- Social Work Experience Preferred

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide social work services to students receiving special education services as outlined in Individualized Education Programs (IEPs).
- Conduct social developmental histories, social work evaluations, and other assessments as required.
- Participate as a member of multidisciplinary evaluation teams and IEP teams.
- Provide individual and group counseling to address social, emotional, behavioral, and educational needs.
- Support students experiencing attendance concerns, behavioral challenges, mental health needs, family difficulties, and crisis situations.
- Collaborate with parents, guardians, school personnel, and community agencies to coordinate services and supports.
- Serve as a liaison between home, school, and community resources.
- Assist in developing and implementing behavioral intervention plans and positive behavior support strategies.
- Participate in Functional Behavioral Assessments (FBAs) and behavior support planning.
- Provide consultation and support to teachers and staff regarding student social-emotional and behavioral needs.
- Maintain accurate documentation and records in compliance with district, state, and federal requirements.
- Assist with crisis intervention, threat assessment processes, and emergency response efforts as needed.
- Attend and actively participate in required meetings, professional development activities, and district initiatives.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Director of Special Education or building administration.
