## 1. Learning Climate/Instruction

 Provide supportive services to individual students whose behavior and/or cognitive level significantly impedes their learning process.

### Staff

- Under the direction of certificated staff, maintain confidentiality, attend to personal needs and comply with IEP goals and objectives for each student assigned.
- Follow up with recommended behavioral and instructional strategies to support positive student management and develop increased learning access and capacity.
- Attend and participate in required professional development and continuing education related to improving student behavior and access to learning.
- Implement documentation procedures of intervention strategies used by staff to monitor student academic and behavior progress.
- Participate in and contribute to meetings/committees as designate.
- Ability to present workshops materials/training to staff

#### PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

The duties of this job require the following physical activities: sitting, standing, reaching, walking, lifting, bending, kneeling, stooping, climbing, pushing, pulling, finger dexterity, carrying, feeling, repetitive motions, speaking, listening, and visual acuity. The employee must lift and/or move up to 10 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus. In addition, the employee must be able to follow written and oral instructions and procedures.
