- 1. Provides instruction to classified students in accordance with each student's individualized education program.
- 2. Sets specific objectives wherever possible in lesson preparation and weekly lesson plans and carries through presentation to effectively achieve these objectives.
- 3. Works cooperatively with regular education teaching staff to coordinate instructional activities and to monitor the progress of each student and provides support instruction in the regular classroom or resource center as assigned.
- 4. Consults with members of the child study team regarding each student's educational program, academic program, and personal growth. Meets at least once annually with the case manager, parents, and other professional staff to review and revise the individualized education program and placement of each assigned student.
- 5. Assists the student in making a realistic assessment of his/her abilities and in establishing educational and occupational goals in keeping with these abilities.
