REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Education/Certification:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Experience as an automotive and truck mechanic.
- Certification for work on diesel and gasoline engines.
- Valid Michigan CDL with Air Brake, Bus (S), and Passenger (P) Endorsements, or able to obtain within six months of hire.
 - Physically able to pass the school bus driver test.
 - Ability to lift a minimum of 135 pounds to waist height.

JOB SCOPE:

The Mechanic is responsible for maintenance, service, repair, and recordkeeping of all district vehicles and equipment—including school buses, maintenance/fleet vehicles, tractors, trucks, snowplows, snow blowers, etc. This role ensures all vehicles meet safety standards and comply with school, local, county, state, and federal regulations.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Maintain preventive maintenance schedules for all fleet vehicles.
- Perform or supervise repairs on all transportation and maintenance equipment.
- Advise on the purchase of fuel, parts, and tools.
- Ensure student transportation vehicles meet Michigan State Police, MDOT, and MDE standards.
- Prepare monthly service and maintenance reports and annual fleet reports for the Transportation Supervisor.
- Maintain high safety standards in all work areas and a clean and organized shop and parts room.
- Daily dispatch duties.
- Maintain certifications through required training.
- Prepare and maintain inventory reports, work orders, and spreadsheets.
- Serve as a substitute driver when necessary.
- Respond to after-hours emergencies, including breakdowns and snow removal.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the supervisor.

Full-time, 12-month position. Must be willing to work additional hours as needed. COMPENSATION: \$26-\$30/hour (based on experience) and benefits package included.
