Qualifications

- Appropriate Illinois teaching license
- Skilled at varied instructional approaches
- Professional demeanor in a variety of settings
- Must have own technology for virtual participation (see “Professional Requirements”)

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Ability to work with a wide range of student abilities/needs
- Ability to provide learning experiences in a variety of settings
- Knowledge of a broad range of instructional strategies
- Knowledge of current technology
- Skilled in professional communication (oral and written) with parents, students and staff
- Able to work collaboratively with teachers, administrators, parents and students to deliver effective instructional opportunities

Professional Requirements

- Maintain complete records regarding student contact, subject and other pertinent information
- Provide a positive learning environment for a variety of student needs
- Deliver curriculum in a manner that engages student(s)
- Establish and maintain a positive, professional rapport with staff, administration, parents and students
- Display flexibility and accessibility when scheduling student tutoring sessions
- Collaborate with all parties to support positive educational outcomes
- Recommended that tutoring be offered:
 1. in presence of parent/guardian
 2. in agreed upon public location
 3. via Zoom

Schedules & Compensation

- Rate of pay is \$35 per hour for direct tutoring (no travel or preparation compensation)
- Students will each be provided 5 hours total of tutoring (for all coursework) per week (ex; 1 hour per day, 1 hour per week per course)
- **Tutoring can only occur on school days (Ex: NOT on holidays, weekends, breaks).**
- Specific amounts of time per week will be assigned to tutor by appropriate D87 staff/school staff
- Tutoring sessions to only occur on days when school is in session for students (see D87 calendar)
- If a student is a no-show more than once (1) time, alert the school administration asap.
