- Works with others to ensure devices and meters are calibrated and working properly
- Selects proper methods, equipment and materials to facilitate cost effective maintenance, projects and repairs
- May improvise acceptable fixes to get equipment and fixtures running promptly while maintaining safety in the facility
- May contact manufacturer's representatives and assist engineers in diagnosing problems and suggesting corrective actions
- Assists the Maintenance Supervisor/Facilities Director and other divisions of the maintenance department, when necessary
- Adjusts, repairs and replaces equipment, fixtures and components
- Responsible for all parts, tools, equipment, and vehicles assigned to them
- Cooperates with all levels of other school system employees and maintains a good working relationship
- Maintains timesheets, logs, paperwork and data related to the work efforts and progress in a timely manner
