

Swim Instructors

Swim Instructor Responsibilities

- Teaching swimming techniques, strokes, and water safety rules to students with varying swimming abilities
- Assisting more experienced swimmers to enhance their swimming abilities
- Assessing the progress of students and adjusting teaching programs accordingly
- Monitoring students to prevent accidents and injuries
- Implementing rules for each swim session
- Ability to modify swim lesson plans that take into account students' abilities and progressive development
- Identifying incorrect swimming techniques and correcting them accordingly
- Aiding in the cleanliness and tidiness of the pool, pool deck, and locker rooms

Swim Instructor Requirements

- CPR and First Aid certifications
- American Red Cross Water Safety Instruction or Basic Swim Instructor certifications, or proof of extensive swimming background (i.e. experience on a swim team or completion of a swim program)
- Sound knowledge of proper swimming techniques and water safety rules
- Strong swimming abilities
- Effective communication skills
- Passionate and enthusiastic

Education, Experience, and Certification Requirements

- Certified Red Cross Lifeguard Training Certificate, or equivalent
- American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer, or equivalent

- American Red Cross Standard First Aid, or equivalent
