ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

The Lifeguard is responsible for guarding the aquatic facility and/or aquatic activities to secure the safety of pool occupants and program participants. The Lifeguard will ensure a safe, fun area for children and adults to interact and enjoy. This position requires early morning, evening, and weekend responsibilities.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Lifeguard certification or equivalent (required)
- Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) for rescue (required)
- First Aid Certification is required within the first 60 days
- AED-Oxygen Certification is required within the first 60 days
- Blood Borne Pathogen training
- State of Michigan Criminal Background Clearance (ICHAT)
- Lifeguard Instructor certification (preferred)

WORK ENVIRONMENT AND PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

The work environment and physical demands described here are representative of those that an employee must meet to perform the essential functions of this job successfully. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform these functions.

- Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos.
- Ability to write simple correspondence.
- Ability to add and subtract two-digit numbers and to multiply and divide with 10's and 100's.

- Ability to define problems, collect data, establish facts, and draw valid conclusions.

The employee must be able to:

- Physically perform all skills required of a lifeguard.
- You can hear noises and distress signals in the aquatic environment, including in the water and anywhere around the zone of responsibility, with or without reasonable accommodation.
- Remain alert with no lapses of consciousness.
- See and observe all sections of an assigned zone of responsibility, with our without reasonable accommodations.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, reach with hands and arms, and talk or hear. The employee is occasionally required to sit and climb or balance. The employee is regularly required to swim, and occasionally required to swim while supporting up to 300 pounds. The employee must regularly lift and/or move more than 100 pounds and frequently lift and/or move up to 100 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include distance vision, peripheral vision, and depth perception; as well as the ability to adjust focus. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to wet, humid conditions and extreme heat. The employee is frequently exposed to toxic or caustic chemicals. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate to loud in an echoing environment.
