Job Summary:

Primary Duties:

Gym Responsibilities

- Oversee the Team, Competitive and Special Olympics Gymnastics programs through Twist 'N' Tumble.
- Develop and implement training programs, lesson plans, and coaching strategies for team gymnasts of all levels.
- Assist in preparing the calendar for each session in a timely manner.
- Update My Skills Chart each session and ensure families, staff, and youth understand and properly utilize the platform with the Program Assistant.
- Assist in youth skill assessments and level placements as needed.
- Regularly observe and instruct classes to ensure they meet TNT's standards.
- Speak to parents regarding their youth's progression, and communicate with the youth enrichment administrative assistant regarding the youth's class levels.
- Coach team and competitive classes throughout the week
- Assist in coordinating camps, open gym and special events programs.

Staffing

- Assist in scheduling & evaluating team coaching staff.
- Work with the Program Assistant in preparing, scheduling, and carrying out training for gymnastics employees
- Assist in tracking, follow-up and implement specialized training & on-boarding of new team staff. Ensure all team staff are up-to-date on certifications and licensing.
- Seek out & complete continuing education on gymnastics through USAG or other resources.

- Assist in marketing campaigns, including social media, newsletters & TNT's website.
- Work closely with the TNT Team Program Assistant to determine goals and direction of programs.
- Regularly update and meet with TNT Team Program Assistant & any additional leadership coaching staff.
- Maintain a clean, safe working environment. Perform periodic equipment safety checks.
- Present a positive professional attitude that reflects the goals and mission statement of TNT.
- Other duties as assigned by the Community Education Leadership team.

- Minimum two years supervising or managing a gymnastics recreational program and/or 5+ years gymnastics coaching.
- Must have or be willing to get current certifications in Safe Sport, USA Gymnastics Required Training, CPR, First Aid & AED.
