The paraprofessional works collaboratively with general and special education staff to promote inclusion and ensure that each student's educational and personal care needs are met in a safe, supportive learning environment.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities The following duties are considered representative of the relative nature and level of the work. These are not to be construed as exclusive or all-inclusive. Other duties may be required and assigned.

- 1. Assist students with staying on task, regulating behavior, and work completion. This will be done under the supervision and guidance of certified teaching staff.
- 2. Help provide accommodations for students in accordance with their IEP requirements
- 3. Attend classrooms with a student or group of students to provide direct support to their learning within the general education environment
- 4. Advocate for students who need support or assistance
- 5. Provide behavior support and help students calm down in a safe environment when they get overwhelmed
- 6. Encourage appropriate social interactions among students
- 7. Ensure that the personal care needs are met for students who require it. Training will be provided by our school nurse for these situations
- 8. Frequent communication with Special Education Case Managers as well as General Education Teachers to help meet the needs of students.
- 9. Help provide a safe and comfortable environment where our students can learn and grow.
