Primary Objective of Position:

To provide an age appropriate early childhood environment and conduct Pre-K classes for children ages three to five which support their physical, intellectual, social/emotional and literacy development.

- Create and submit lesson plans in the areas of literacy, physical, social/emotional and intellectual development that will prepare children for school success.
- Conduct assessments and record assessment data on all children.
- Attend staff meetings and trainings as required.
- Participate on the Advisory Council as appropriate.
- Attend and participate in PLC collaborative team meetings.
- Keep informed of current trends in the Early Childhood field through in-service training.
- Parent communication via newsletters, phone calls, emails and parent/teacher conferences.
- Plan and implement family engagement nights to promote parent participation and education.
- Assist in outreach and public relations activities.
- Maintain a stimulating, healthy and clean classroom environment.
- Perform other appropriate duties as assigned.
