**SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITIES**

Assist with designing, implementing, and reporting district, state, and federal programs. Assist local schools and departments in monitoring programs. Plan, develop, and implement training programs. Plan and develop automated data systems to provide services for users. Troubleshoots the data system. Assumes responsibility of liaison between the department and MIS.

**PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES & EVALUATION CRITERIA**

- Assist staff with automated equipment operation and application of software.
- Monitor services and troubleshoots as the liaison between the department and MIS.
- Assist in planning data bases and data retrieval systems, and provides liaison with data processing specialists for implementation.
- Prepare specifications for adhoc reports and mass updates. Produce reports from data bases.
- Assist in preparing, maintaining and updating data/information.
- Perform studies for departments, offices, and agencies as required.
- Assist in compliance with district and/or community requests for special data requirements.
- Prepare annual and interim reports for district, state and federal programs.
- Maintain accurate data and conduct analysis of data for evaluations using electronic data processing equipment.
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervisor

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS**

The work is primarily sedentary. It requires the ability to communicate effectively using speech, vision and hearing. The work requires the use of hands for simple grasping and fine manipulations. The work at times requires bending, squatting, reaching, with the ability to lift, carry, push or pull light weights.
