Position: Special Education Academic Lead Teacher

Pay Grade: Teacher Pay Scale

Primary Purpose: The Special Education ALT is a special education teacher who leads the special education department for the campus by serving as a resource principals, teachers and other staff while maintaining a teaching caseload for special education students.

- Bachelor's degree in education or other related field.
- Master's degree in Special Education from an accredited university preferred.
- Valid Texas teaching certificate or endorsement in Special Education.
- Previous experience in improving outcomes for students with disabilities preferred

Special Knowledge/Skills:

- Advanced knowledge of curriculum and instruction
- Knowledge of special education federal, state, and local guidelines
- Ability to support special education instructional programs and teaching effectiveness
- Ability to manage budget and personnel
- Ability to organize and coordinate projects
- Ability to interpret and apply policy and procedures to respond to student data
- Ability to instruct students and manage their behavior
- Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills
- Ability to recognize the characteristics of high quality teaching in special education classroom

- Supports the building principal with the daily operations of supporting teachers in serving and meeting the needs of special education students
- Serves as mentor to new special education team members and supports all teachers through modeling, coaching and professional development
- Ensures timelines are met in accordance with federal, state, and local policies and procedures
- Monitors the implementation of special education services
- Supports instructional staff with improving Special Education instruction.
- Monitors and responds to Special Education data
- Leads department PLCS for special education teachers monthly
- Ensures campus implementation of district practices and procedures for special education
- Collaborates with EAS (Diag), LSSPs and other service providers to develop appropriate IEPS for students
- Coordinates and supports the transition of students between campuses
- Performs the duties and responsibilities of a special education teacher for the teaching caseload
