Scope of Responsibilities

To provide instruction to students, at least 18 year of age, for the Kalamazoo Adult Education program. Two levels of math instruction are provided by the instructor – Pre HSE (6-8) and HSE (9-12). To advance adults towards perficiency at GED level.

Performance Responsibilities

- 1. Assess the academic needs of each student.
- 2. Develop educational plans within the classroom for students to complete his or her educational goal
- 3. Create lessons that correlate to each individual's instructional level.
- 4. Provide students contextualized learning for English, citizenship, and soft skills for employability. Three areas of focus are governmental agencies.
- 5. Maintain records of student's progress and participation using attendance sheets, adult learning plans, and state-required assessments for progress and improvement and post-tests.
- 6. Use various instructional methods, materials, and tools to tailor learning for each student and group learning.
- 7. Manage and monitor student behavior in classroom and building (reports to AE Leader when necessary).
- 8. Assist AE Leader with the implementation of positive, responsible behavior strategies.
- 9. Perform other duties as directed by AE Leader.

Minimum Qualifications

- 1. A valid Michigan K-8 certification
- 2. Knowledge of the characteristics of adult learners
- 3. Excellent written and oral communications skills
- 4. Experience in developing individualized educational or adult learning plans
- 5. Experience in administering formal assessments for student skill evaluation
- 6. Ability to work a flexible schedule
- 7. Ability to work in a satellite program that requires interaction with other agency employees.
- 8. Ability to interact successfully with a diverse population of students that create a multi-cultural setting

9. Technology/computer usage.

Desirable Qualifications

- 1. Ability to read, write and speak
- 2. Training in learning styles for students
- 3. Past experience in working with adults with learning disabilities
